

Corban University adheres to the security requirements established by the Federal Trade Commission (FTC). These requirements are as follows:

- All consumer information is safeguarded: applies to all nonpublic personal information in the school's possession
- Corban has established and maintains a comprehensive information security program that includes administrative, technical, and physical safeguards to protect customer information
- Corban has all required elements of an information security program:
  - Designated coordinators
  - Risk assessment: identifies potential risk and mitigates through employee training, information systems, and the detection and response to attacks and intrusions
  - Safeguards testing/ monitoring: implementation of safeguards based on the risk assessment done by the school
  - Evaluation/adjustment: Corban evaluates and adjusts the security program based on the safeguards/testing information obtained
  - Overseeing service providers: Corban makes an effort to ensure that the services providers employed by the school are capable of maintaining appropriate safeguards
